<b>8 March 2005</b>	Planning application received
<b>23 March 2005</b>	BBNP tell AB need extend the 8 week evaluation period
<b>23 March 2005</b>	Blank notice to consultees
<b>7 April 2005</b>	BBNP to archaeologist (manuscript no comment on foot of letter returned)
<b>14 April 2005</b>	Technical and Local Services to BBNP ask for detailed plan show access and visibility to thoroughly consider the proposal
<b>14 April 2005</b>	Advert in newspaper
<b>19 April 2005</b>	Clerk to Talybont-on-Usk Community Council (TUCC) email confirm application supported by TUCC ask for condition re access route
<b>27 April 2005</b>	Local resident (Stuart) objection letter
<b>28 April 2005</b>	Local residents (G & M Kneen) objection letter
<b>28 April 2005</b>	Site notice & consultation expires
<b>29 April 2005</b>	Email from Alison Brown (Area Dev Control Officer) requesting condition on visibility
<b>9 May 2005</b>	Jon Young letter to BBNP confirming visited office that week – told comments still being accepted
<b>9 May 2005</b>	Clerk to TUCC emailed Kate Edwards advise concerns, ask extend consult period, confirms will write after next council meeting on 16 May 2005

<b>13 May 2005</b>	List of Applications for Meeting with Chair/Deputy Chair Development Control (says delegated to permit)
<b>16 May 2005</b>	TUCC email deep concerns – told application permitted and public have had time to comment – said would seek to reverse this decision as BBNP knew further concerns forthcoming from TUCC
<b>25 &amp; 29 May 2005</b>	Letters to Eric Bowles ask application subject to a new consultation due to errors and misleading description (from Mary Taylor and Hazel Appleyard and Hamill-Keays)
<b>30 May 2005</b>	Objection letter from Mr Furwood received by BBNP (only just heard about application)
<b>31 May 2005</b>	Objection letter from P Needham received by BBNP
<b>31 May 2005</b>	Objection letter from Bennetts received by BBNP (said only found out about application 2 days ago)
<b>31 May 2005</b>	Objection letter from Astrid Inglis received by BBNP (said only found out about application on 27 May 2005)
<b>2 June 2005</b>	Objection letter from Mrs Pursell received by BBNP
<b>3 June 2005</b>	Objection letter from S Williams received by BBNP (notice only displayed for a short time)
<b>3 June 2005</b>	Objection letter from Roger Raikes (Chairman – Brecknock Branch CPRW) inadequate description/consultation
<b>6 June 2005</b>	BBNP acknowledgment Letter to Pursell (no comment on contents of her letter)
<b>17 June 2005</b>	Delegated Decision Report (signed by Maxine Lewis)
<b>21 June 2005</b>	Planning permission
<b>22 June 2005</b>	Planning permission sent to applicants – advised no modifications without consent
<b>22 June 2005</b>	Letter BBNP to S Rees (says copied to all neighbours who wrote in – <b>no other copies on file</b> ) confirmed application allowed conditionally
<b>22 July 2005</b>	TUCC asks to be consulted on permission conditions

<b>6 October 2005</b>	BBNP discharges condition 16
<b>16 January 2006</b>	BBNP discharges conditions 12, 13, 14 and 15
<b>27 January 2006</b>	Site licence
<b>3 February 2006</b>	Complaint letter to BBNP from applicants re way TUCC dealt with their application (audio tape available ) <b>(not on file)</b>
<b>9 February 2006 (date stamped by BBNP)</b>	Conduct of Complaint form completed by applicant
<b>17 February 2006</b>	Letter BBNP to applicants – all conditions discharged
<b>24 July 2006</b>	Memo from BE to E Bowles – confirms he took into consideration when considering the application that could have up to 600 people on site but thought it unlikely to happen on a regular basis. Also states knew site was exceeding 28 day rule. Believed whole site previously unrestricted so 50 maximum was an environmental improvement
<b>3 August 2006</b>	Audrey Oakley response to complaints letter
<b>26 October 2006</b>	Lynne Coughlan responds to letter of complaint from P Needham (enc copy letter BE to AB 11 February 2005)
<b>21 December 2006</b>	Memo from Lynne Coughlan to BE ask him to respond to points raised by P Needham re the memo to EB dated 24 July 2006 <b>(no response)</b>
